- In 2014 the Council District Service Center budgeted \$1 million to split among all districts. However, the amount was later reduced to \$750k. From this source, \$100k was used for new sidewalks in Braeburn Glen.
- City of Houston 2020 budget (July 1-June 30)
  - \$25k allocated for the traffic diverter improvements
  - The CoH will cover costs and installation of three (3) speed cushions
